

MSX Printer cable

A MSX printer cable is a special cable between the 14 pins connector on the MSX and the 'Centronics' connector on parallel printers. The connectors are of the same type. Quite limited, only 8 databits, ground, strobe and busy.

It is easy to construct with good available connectors.

The next picture shows how the connections are to be made.

Components:

1x 14 pins ribbon connector male

1x 36 pins ribbon cable male (referred to as "Centronics" printer connector)
cable with 11 wires, length limited to a couple of meters!
